PACK YOUR BAGS!

The AdventureWomen team has curated this list for your adventure in Morocco. It is meant to provide packing guidelines, but please also think about how you travel and what works for you as individuals. If you have <u>any</u> questions, please don't hesitate to ask! It's what we are here for.

Packing Considerations

Morocco generally has a tropical climate, with temperatures as high as 95°F, but it can get down to the 40s in the Sahara and in the mountains. The temperature should be moderate during the day and cool in the evenings. There is a possibility of rain, but not constant rainfall. Please remember to check the weather before you depart.

You can have laundry done along the way or wash it by hand. We recommend planning on doing laundry when you are staying somewhere for two nights or more.

Morocco is a conservative country. Please be sure to cover your knees, shoulders and chest when visiting cultural sites. Long tops that go past your elbows and waist work well.
